Set in the rugged hills above the city of Málaga, this charming country property comprises two separate dwellings in a dramatic, peaceful setting. The main house is a large, single-storey traditional finca, much of which likely dates to the early 20th century, with a registered reform in 1996. Inside you'll find three bedrooms, a kitchen, separate living room, family kitchen, and bathroom, along with a laundry and various storerooms.

The second dwelling is a one-bedroom bungalow with open-plan living room and kitchen plus a good-sized bathroom. Beside it are a large store and extensive covered terraces, ideal for shaded outdoor living and practical day-to-day use.

Access is via an unmade road maintained by the town hall, approximately 1.6 km from the main road—a suitably rural approach for those seeking nature, quiet and big-sky views.

The current owners operate a licensed kennels & cattery business with an excellent reputation and regular repeat clients (local and from neighbouring provinces). Facilities include 21 dog lodges, 5 catteries, 6 short-stay kennels, and care for other small pets. New owners are welcome to take over the business at no additional charge.
